DUTIES

- Assist with set up, lighting of candles, extinguishing candles tear down
- Assist with maintenance of the Garden, such as snow removal, ice maintenance, restocking of supplies
- Cleaning up from the previous night, restocking firewood, checking on the displays
- Closing gates and extinguishing fire pits at the end of the night
- Providing safety on site
- **Other duties as required**
